Dr. Manfred J. Kern born in 1952 in Bodenheim, Germany, where his family operated a wine-growing estate. He is married, has two daughters and two grand children. He earned his doctorate at the Johannes-Gutenberg-University in Mainz, Germany on the subject of "Brain Aging in Insects" in 1982. He is a graduate biologist, futurologist, and managing director of agriExcellence e.K. worked in the chemical crop protection industry for Hoechst AG, AgrEvo GmbH, Aventis Crop Science AG and Bayer Crop Science AG. Over the past 40 years he has held key positions in science and technology, strategy, marketing and communications.

He is nationally and internationally a highly reputed, creative and innovative scientist, author, co-editor, editorial board member, speaker, communicator, consultant, teacher, motivator, and inspirer in the field of crop and animal health, agri-food and life sciences and many more. He has filled many patents and has more than 200 publications in international and national journals and books to his credit. He shared his extraordinary and unique knowledge in more than 1,200 presentations at international/national congresses, conferences, symposia, workshops, and public at large in over 80 countries. He is a founder member and Vice-President of IFSDAA (International Foundation for Sustainable Development in Africa and Asia), Goettingen, Germany since 2007.

He has been running the project of "Agriculture: Vision 2025/2050", a comprehensive and still running study on the safeguarding of world food supplies and production of healthy food, since 1995. He is a famous futurologist, i.e., building bridges to the future and people worldwide. As a positive thinking and acting visionary, his vision and mission was not only to foresee the future, but to enable a better future on earth. "Do more with less, better and in time!"

He deliverd lectures on "Future of Agriculture" at JMS (Junior Mangement School) in Monheim, Germany between 2006 and 2011. He has been teaching as Senior Fellow at the Center for Development Research (ZEF) at the Rheinische Friedrich-Wilhelm-University of Bonn, Germany since 2004. He functioned as peer for external evaluations of many university programs in Germany (AQAS e.V., ZEvA) as well as the University of Peace, Costa Rica in 2013 (SINAES). He acted as an expert participating in the evaluation of the "HORIZON 2020" programs of the European Commission in 2020.

He was Lieutenant-Colonel (P.) in the Euro-Corps, commander of a bataillon (res.), and decorated with the silver medal of the German Armed Forces.
